

## THE PARENT PLEDGE

6. To go directly to the teacher in a Christian manner if questions or concerns arise. (Matthew 18:15) "If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you. If he listens to you, you have won your brother over."
7. To take an active role in seeing that my child's assigned homework is completed and to provide an opportunity for completing the task.
8. To take an active role in parent-teacher conferences, meetings and other educational programs that provide informative 'parenting' helps.
9. To support my child's extracurricular activities and to encourage commitment to them.
10. To make every effort to insure my child attends school classes regularly.
11. For Trinity members to be aware of Trinity Lutheran Church and School's financial expenses and support to each as the Lord has blessed them.
12. In order to get parents more involved in our school, it is expected that each family will volunteer a minimum of twenty hours per year at our school or church.
