During 4<sup>th</sup> quarter, Trinity Lutheran School will be collecting items that are needed at Camp Fish Tales for summer camp. Items will be collected through June 2<sup>nd</sup> and can be brought to school or placed in the box located in the back of the church. **Items needed:** free and clear laundry detergent, baby wipes (NOT disinfecting wipes), acrylic paint (small bottles), white copy paper (for crafts), paper products (plates, Styrofoam bowls, napkins, paper towels, bowls, 8-12 ounce cups, plasticware), toilet paper and tissue, colored tissue paper, rolls of butcher paper, dry erase markers, glitter, beads (need to be able to fit a pipe cleaner), kid friendly sunblock, and kid friendly bug spray.
